Building Details

- Four-story, 76,800-square-foot building
- 1102 S. Park restores the vibrancy these city blocks once knew during the Bancroft Dairy era
- The building adds two community services that were not previously available in the area
 - A community room for health care teach-ins, neighborhood association meetings and public gatherings
 - A full-service pharmacy
- 1102 S. Park will be a LEED certified building in support of the U.S. Green Building Council's vision: To transform the way buildings and communities are designed, built and operated, enabling an environmentally and socially responsible, healthy, and prosperous environment that improves the quality of life
 - ▶ 78% of all construction debris/waste was diverted from landfills and recycled

- High efficiency plumbing fixtures account for a 30% overall water savings
- ▶ All materials used within the building shell are low-VOC, contributing to improved indoor air quality

In Support of Wingra Creek B.U.I.L.D.

The project was designed and built in the spirit of the Wingra Creek B.U.I.L.D. Project, a comprehensive neighborhood revitalization plan that identifies the 1102 S. Park site as a key transitional property for redevelopment of the area.

Building Project Team

Ghidorzi Companies is the developer, architect, builder and interior designer for the \$25.2 million project. Numerous financial partners and government entities collaborated to make 1102 S. Park feasible, including BMO Harris, City of Madison, US Bank, WHEDA and Wisconsin of Department of Commerce through economic development tools, including grants, Tax Incremental Funding and New Market Tax Credits.
